For Best Results When Making Dipsy Dog

- 1. Always use a dry hot dog. This is very important
- 2. The directions are on the back of every box. Each individual box is 5lbs of dry mix.
- 3. First combine 3 lbs (1.5 quarts) of cold water with a full box of Dipsy Dog in a mixing bowl.
 - If mixing with a machine, use a wire whip and mix on a low speed for 1 minute and then scrape the bowl.
 - Then change the speed to a medium speed and mix for 2 minutes. At this point the batter should be smooth.
- 4. Let the batter stand for 10 minutes
- 5. Dip the hot dog in the batter and allow the excess batter to drain off. Make sure the entire dog is encased in the batter.
- 6. Fry the dog submerged in preheated 375 degree deep fat for about 2-3 minutes.
- 7. Serve hot and enjoy the sweet taste of Victor's Dipsy Dog mix.

This product can typically coat 45-50 hot dogs per 5lb box. The number of dogs coated can change based on the size of the hot dog. A typical serving size is 3tbs.
